Directions for Plastic Freshie Molds

- Preheat your oven to 330-335 degrees. Do NOT go above or leave in too long or you WILL damage the mold. (Toaster Oven is not suggested, but no more than 195 degrees!)
- You will need to test your own oven. I bake at 330-335 for 11 minutes. Use 45 second intervals, if you need more time.
- DO NOT OVERCOOK!
- 4) Use parchment paper on your pan.
- 5) Place your molds on pan, wide edge down.
- 6) Place you nail inside the mold appropriately.
- 7) Fill your mold to the top and level off. If you're not filling it to the top, be sure to fill the corners and ends higher. Use additional time in 45 second intervals.
 - Use chop stick to test top to see if done. The chop stick will come off the beads. If the beads come UP with the chop stick, put in for another 45 seconds to a minute.
- 8) Cool molds before removing freshie.
- Place mold on counter face down and apply pressure from the back with your thumb.
- 10) Apply pressure as needed, to remove.
- 11) ** DO NOT USE SILICONE SPRAY OR PAM. It could damage the mold and color could come off on your freshie. Wash molds with gentle soap and water.
